COACH'S CODE OF CONDUCT: *As a Coach, I recognize that this game is about and for the kids and coaches are role models for their team members and all participants involved in the activity, and that sports help to develop a sense of teamwork, self worth and sportsmanship. As such, I agree to abide by the following:*

- 1 Place the emotional and physical well being of my players ahead of a personal desire or external pressure to win.
- 2 Treat game officials with respect and use reasonable effort to ensure that my players, spectators and supporters do the same.
- 3 Never knowingly permit an ineligible player to play on my team or withhold information from another coach or organization concerning potentially ineligible players on their team
- 4 Conduct myself and use reasonable effort to ensure that my players, spectators and supporters conduct themselves in a manner that is consistent with good sportsmanship - before, during and after every game.
- 5 Read and abide by the rules and guidelines for the league.
- 6 Never schedule other league games or scrimmages that conflict with the regular season and/or make-up games.
- 7 Communicate my expectations about practices and games to my players and their parents.
- 8 Keep my players and their parents informed about the rules, schedules and other league-related information.
- 9 Ensure that my players are supervised by myself or another designated adult and never allow my players to be left unattended or unsupervised at a game or practice.
- 10 Use reasonable effort to ensure that all equipment used by my players is safe and conforms to the rules of the game. I will report defective equipment to the Commissioner.
- 11 Never knowingly permit an injured player to play or return to the game without proper medical approval.
- 12 Refrain from using alcoholic beverages, illegal substances or tobacco while in direct supervision of my players.
- 13 Never physically, verbally or mentally harm a child in my care.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION: Violations to the Code of Conduct and all other incidents where a complaint has been recognized may result in disciplinary action, which may include up to immediate dismissal/suspension. The Commissioner, Director and the GRC Sports Committee will determine all disciplinary actions.
