

GRD Alcohol Policy

(Adopted 9-2008)

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish the rules on the consumption of alcohol on the properties managed by the GRD.

Scope

This policy applies to McPeek Lodge and the Spring Valley shelter house. It applies to no other properties managed by the GRD.

Policy

1. The sale of alcoholic beverages is absolutely prohibited.

2. Persons using the facility are responsible for complying with all state and local liquor regulations.

3. There will be no loud noise or inappropriate conduct that will infringe on the reasonable privacy of other individuals.

4. The permit holder shall be responsible for ensuring that the activities conducted are contained within the area which is reserved.

5. The permit holder shall be responsible for ensuring that alcoholic beverages are not served to minors. The Granville Police or Licking County Sheriff will conduct periodic checks of reserved facilities to ensure compliance with state statutes governing the consumption of alcohol.

The GRD retains the right to revoke, modify, or cancel the policy at any time and it sees appropriate.
