

Granville Ballpark League 6U Division Rules 2014

1. No scores or standings will be kept
2. No umpires will be used
3. Up to 4 defensive and 4 offensive coaches will be allowed on the field for instruction purposes. No coach shall touch a live ball or touch a player while the ball is live.
4. Up to 12 defensive players may play on the field at a time. Our goal is to have at least 5 of these players be in the infield (P, 1B, 2B, SS, 3B)...it's not difficult to have 7 defensive players in the infield at one time. If outfielders are used, they should be positioned in the grass of the outfield.
5. If a child must sit during an inning due to having too many players, that child may not sit another inning for the next 11 innings.
6. A team must have at least 5 players to play a game.
7. The entire roster will bat once each inning. The last batter will be an automatic homerun to clear the bases.
8. No strikeouts. Every batter will put the ball in play.
9. No bunting.
10. No stealing.
11. First half of the season coaches are free to offer up to 3 "pitches" to a batter. Second half of the season, players will receive up to 3 pitches from a coach. If the player has not put the ball fairly in play after three pitches, the ball will be placed on the tee. The ball must be put in play.
12. All hits will be considered singles.
13. Outs will be declared for the purpose of instructing the defense, but players will not be removed from the bases / field as a result of an "out." Bases will be cleared after each set of three outs within an inning in order to instruct the rules of the game. Each team will always bat its entire roster each inning.

14. Home team will be responsible for setting up the field, including making sure that all necessary equipment is at the field. The visiting team is responsible for raking the field, and returning equipment, including bases.
15. There will be a 1 hour or 4 inning limit to games, whichever comes first. No inning shall start with less than 15 minutes left before the time limit.
16. All other tee ball rules apply (see LL rule book).
